LIVING LIFE WITH NO REGRETS - A MUSICAL TRIBUTE TO EDITH PIAF

6 April 2011 – Discover the magical story of Edith Piaf, the most celebrated French music icon of all time with *No Regrets, A Tribute to Edith Piaf*. A musical revue paying homage to Piaf's extraordinary life, it will feature a stellar cast of performers including established theatre talents Hossan Leong, Robin Goh, Denise Tan and Angela Scundi. The revue will also mark newcomer Hilde Holme's stage debut. First produced by homegrown French theatre company Sing'theatre in 2007, *No Regrets, A Tribute to Edith Piaf* will return to stage from 4 to 14 May 2011 at the DBS Arts Centre in celebration of the company's 5th anniversary. *No Regrets, A Tribute to Edith Piaf* is presented by BNP Paribas.

This cabaret inspired performance will showcase a repertoire of 22 songs, among them classics such as *La vie en rose*; *No Regrets* and *The Three Bells*. From her troubled childhood to her meteoric rise as a singing sensation, through her many love affairs and emotional struggles, she triumphed to become the highest paid singer in the world. Tragedy only seemed to push her to even greater heights. About Edith Piaf

Born into a life of squalor, Edith Piaf was abandoned by her mother and was raised in a cheap Normandy brothel. As a child, she became blind, but miraculously recovered a few years later. Her first big break came thanks to the cabaret owner Louis Leplée, who taught her the basics of stage presence and told her to wear a black dress, which later became her signature apparel. Her only child died of meningitis at the age of two. And her great romance with the boxer Marcel Cerdan ended in tragedy, as her lover died in a plane crash on his way to meet her in New York.

Some of her songs include *La Vie en rose*, *Padam...*, *Padam...*, *Non, je ne regrette rien, L'hyme à l'amour* and *Heureuse*. Love, separation and abandonment played an important part in her songs, giving them authenticity and power. By 1946, she had not only won the hearts of those in Europe, but had also received rapturous reviews for her performances in the United States despite failing to attract large audiences for her first concerts. Piaf's *La Vie en rose* earned a Grammy Hall of Fame Award in 1998.
