Sing'theatre is a non-profit theatre company created in 2006 to promote cultural exchanges and to contribute to Singapore's nationwide efforts to bring arts and culture to everyone, everywhere, every day.

It is the first local company to produce shows in English with Singapore-based artists drawing on French cultural heritage.

Sing'theatre believes sharing our cultural heritage between our communities can enhance the quality of our relationships. We believe Art is a fundamental right for everyone regardless of status or health. Following Sing'theatre's efforts to build bridges and mutual understanding between European and Singaporean cultures, Sing'theatre was recognized in May 2011 by the Ministry of Information, Communications and the Arts (MICA) for its **contribution to Singapore** and was granted Institution of Public Character status **(IPC)**, allowing its donors and patrons **double tax exemption**.

For the past 6 years, Sing'theatre has staged one show a year with productions presenting iconic French and European singers, as well as plays and musicals written in Singapore.
